

## Our goal

The Upper Room works with socially disadvantaged people to improve their lives and give them a second chance. Our main aim is to help people regain their self-respect and improve their health, in order to find work and become economically independent.

## How do we do it?

- UR4Meals provides meals and essential survival services for the homeless and vulnerable
- UR4Jobs offers a multilingual specialist employment support service for migrant workers
- UR4Driving is an award-winning programme which teaches ex-offenders to drive, and puts them through the driving test in return for voluntary work in our Foodbank

## What we need from you

The Upper Room receives the majority of its income from grant-giving trusts and charitable foundations, but most of this money is earmarked for specified activities relating to the services that we offer. Unrestricted funding is, therefore, an extremely valuable form of income, as we need to be able to maintain the core functions of the Charity.

We are presently establishing a Friends of The Upper Room to improve our support base in the local community and to raise invaluable unrestricted funds. We hope that:

- Friends of The Upper Room will commit to a minimum of £50 per year single contribution, £75 per year for a joint contribution
- Organisations or local groups who become corporate Friends of The Upper Room will commit to a minimum of £100 per year
